STUDY GUIDE

- **What observations can be made about:**
 - The manner of prayer called for
 - The kind of awareness that is to be maintained
 - The scope of supplication encouraged
 - The description of the gospel proclamation
 - Paul's status as a citizen and how that affects his ministry
 - The "ought to" statement in verse 20
 - In what ways prayer is depicted as a spiritual weapon here

- **What does each of these things mean? What did they mean for the church at Ephesus then, what do they mean for us now?**

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION

Use any or as many of these questions as will be helpful for your discussion.

- What has God spoken to you about this week regarding the sermon or passage?
- What does this passage reveal to us about Jesus?
- How does this passage enhance our understanding of the Gospel?
- What does this text mean for us as a community? Individually? How does it free us to be the people God intends for us to be?
- How do we need to live out the meaning of this text in our city?
- JR said this week that "Light dispels darkness when people hear, understand and believe the message of Jesus." In your daily interactions are you thinking about dispelling darkness, or preserving your reputation?
- What does it mean that "sin is the only thing that qualifies us for mercy"?
- JR also said this week that, "Light dispels darkness when people experience the mercy of Jesus". What needs do you see in our city that need the mercy of Jesus and how will you exercise it there?
- What will it look like for you to enlarge your "missional footprint"?
